- Shape the Process of Discipleship & points of Emphasis

DEFINITION OF SIN

Now a man came up to Jesus and asked, "Teacher, what good thing must I do to get eternal life?" "Why do you ask me about what is good?" Jesus replied. "There is only One who is good. If you want to enter life, obey the commandments."

- SIN AND TEN COMMANDMENTS
- DID JESUS FORGET THE TEN COMMANDMENTS?

10 COMMANDMENTS

- 1. NO OTHER GODS
- 2. NO IDOLS
- 3. DO NOT TAKE LORD'S NAME IN VAIN
- 4. KEEP THE SABBATH
- 5. HONOR YOUR FATHER 10. DO NOT COVET AND YOUR MOTHER

- 6. NO MURDER
- 7. NO ADULTERY
- 8. DO NOT STEAL
- 9. DO NOT BEAR **FALSE WITNESS**

THE IDOL OF THE RICH YOUNG MAN MATTHEW 19:21

THE IDOL OF THE RICH YOUNG MAN MATTHEW 19:21

- 1. You shall have no other gods before Me.
- 2. You shall make no idols.
- 3. Not take the name of the Lord in vain.
- 4. Keep the Sabbath day holy.
- 5. You shall not covet.

RE-DEFINITION OF SIN: IDOLS

- If Sin is defined only by outside behavior
 - Jesus redefine Sin: Idols
 - The young man's idol: WEALTH

- Has nothing to do with "Good Works"
- Has Everything to do with the "Good One"
- Relationship with the Good One is the key

- Behavior that fits the standard

- Experience Truth
- Integration of God's Love
- Service motivated by vision, desiring to experience God
- Fruit of the Spirit –Positive emotions

YOUR EMOTIONS IN DISCIPLESHIP

"Emotions do not authenticate truth, but emotions do authenticate our understanding and integration of truth."

- To experience Truth/ God's Love
- To uncover our idols through negative emotions

IF WE DO NOT REDEFINE SIN

- Focus on outward behavior, but not the inner reality and relationship
 - We develop an attitude of "Earning" / "Deserving" – Eternal life

IF WE DO NOT REDEFINE SIN

- Neglect the role of Emotions play in discipleship
- Hidden Idols/ Sins that entangles us without resolution
