



Mark 2:1-12 Jesus forgives and heals a paralyzed man. "Your sins are forgiven."


Mark 2:13-17 Jesus dines with tax collectors and sinners. "It is not the healthy that need a doctor but the sick."

They "were hungry and in need."


Mark 3:1-6 Jesus heals on the Sabbath. "Which is lawful on the Sabbath: to do good or to do evil, to save life or to kill?"
